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## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

### SCOPE

A mentorship program (i.e. providing mentor-coach matches, community of practice, professional development opportunities) to provide greater supports to coaches in parasport. A wide range of coaching contexts were targeted for the program cohorts (Grassroots to Provincial Level) with the experience of apprentice coaches in coaching parasport ranging from 0-5 years. 3 cohorts have completed the program since 2020.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Provide 50 parasport coaches with mentorship support
- Train apprentices in NCCP Coaching Athletes with a Disability
- Train mentors/apprentices and broader coach audeience in leadership series

### KEY LINKS TO OPC STRATEGY

- Support strategies including peer coaching, professional development and other tools are created
- Contribute to 70 Coach Apprentices
- Contribute to 220 Parasport Coaches Trained











### **Key Challenges**

Building a community of practice around the mentorship program.

in 2021-2022 we started utilizing a digital platform to develop community of practice. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic in-person events were not possible during first 2 cohorts and coaches were still hesitant to return to in-person activities in 2022-2023.
